The Office of Member of Parliament Atty. Maisara C. Dandamun-Latiph continues to support the Education Sector amidst the challenges being encountered by both teachers and students brought by the pandemic. (28) Schools Districts received Multi-Functional Digital Printer. This is under the Transitional Development Impact Fund (TDIF) funded by the Bangsamoro Government with the support of the Ministry of Basic and Technical Education (MBHTE).

The Office of MP Atty. Maisara provided Cash Grant worth of Php 10,000 each organization in recognition of their great efforts for their respective communities. Cash Grant will also serve as a funding for their future project and activities for Social Development.

How time flies. We are now in the 3rd quarter of 2021. So much has been accomplished by our office as a Member of the BTA Parliament.

We begin with our primordial legislative advocacy for Lake Lanao for the passage of BTA Bill No. 32 or an "Act Creating the Ranao Development Authority" a regulatory body that will oversee the rehabilitation and development of our beloved Ranao.

For this, we conducted clean up drive in lake shore areas. Followed by our Focus Group Discussion on Ranao in Aid of Legislation. Participants from various sectors expressed their grave concerns over the state of health of Ranao and call for the Bangsamoro Government to preserve and conserve the lake by the immediate passage of BTA Bill No. 32.

In the matter of aiding and supporting our citizens, aside from delivering our regular monthly office programs, we have rendered social services assistance thru our 2020 Transitional Impact Development Fund (TDIF) wherein we have allocated a majority of our TDIF (Php 17.5M) for the payout of much needed financial assistance to the vulnerable citizens of the Bangsamoro. This program was implemented under the leadership of Interim Chief Minister Ahod B. Ebrahim and the Ministry of Social Services headed by Atty. Raissa Jajurie.

In battling the pandemic thru education, we turned-over 28 Risograph Duplicator Heavy Duty machines to 28 school districts in Lanao del Sur implemented thru the Ministry of Education worth 3.8M. To aid our citizens in Tugaya, Lanao del Sur, we have also broken ground to install 150 pcs Solar Street Lights worth 4.2M implemented thru the Ministry of Public Works. In the matter of Rido Settlement we have allocated 500K for this thru the Ministry of Public Order and Safety.

Alhamdulillah, that our Office did more than what is possible this pandemic. We hope that in the last quarter, we can serve bigger and better in fulfillment of our mandates and our advocacies for the vulnerable sector with the aim of uplifting and improving their lives this pandemic.

In accordance with its legislative functions, the Office of MP Atty. Maisara Dandamun-Latiph filed eight (8) resolutions for the third

quarter of 2021 with six (6) of them duly adopted by the Bangsamoro Parliament and the remaining two referred to appropriate committees. They are as follows:

RANAO DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

On September 20, 2021, the Office of MP Atty. Maisara Dandamun-Latiph was invited by the Bangsamoro Attorney General’s Office to present the salient features of BTA-Bill No. 32, which seeks to create the Ranao Development Authority. MP Maisara was represented by her Chief of Staff Atty. Abduljabbar Guro who presented the salient features of the bill as well as the organizational structure of the proposed government agency to the lawyers of various ministries of the Bangsamoro Government. Atty. Guro emphasized the need for the creation of the government agency that will protect and rehabilitate Lake Lanao considering the present conditions obtaining in the province of Lanao del Sur. The legal representatives of the various government agencies asked legal questions and suggested provisions that will enhance the bill.



At present, a technical working group (TWG) has been organized by the Committee on Rules in order to conduct public consultations for BTA-Bill No. 32. Having undergone second reading, BTA-Bill No. 32 is expected to be calendared for third reading after the public consultations have been conducted and a corresponding committee report has been submitted to the Committee.

SIYAP KO RANAW (CARE FOR LAKE LANAOS) CLEAN UP DRIVE IN LAKESHORE AREAS



Lake Lanao is one of the most important body of water in Mindanao. It serves not only the Meranaws but also the neighboring cities and Municipalities.

Due to improper waste disposal, the lake is now facing threat as native fish species are now vanishing.

Thus, the Office of MP Atty. Maisara Dandamun-Latiph in partnership with the Local Government Unit of Marantao Lanao del Sur headed by Honorable Mayor Akira Alonto, BARMM-Ministry of Environment, Natural Resources, and Energy (Lanao del Sur) headed by Forester Asmarie M. Labao, and National Power Corporation had implemented a Clean Up Drive in the (3) Barangays of Marantao Lanao Del Sur.

This aims to Promote the beauty of Lake Lanao, Engage individuals in preserving the Lake Lanao, and Raise awareness on the current situation of the Lake Lanao.

This is also in support for the BTA-Parliament Bill No. 32, entitled: "An Act Creating the Ranaw Development Authority Prescribing Its Powers and Functions and Appropriating Funds Therefor.", authored by MP Atty. Maisara Latiph.

WHAT IS TRANSITIONAL DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FUND OR TDIF?

Transitional Development Impact Fund or TDIF is funded by the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) under the leadership of Interim Chief Minister Ahod Ibrahim Murad, Al-Haj through the Office of Members of Parliament in partnership with different ministries. Among the chosen TDIF Projects of the Office of MP Atty. Maisara is the financial assistance programs of the Ministry of Social Services and Development (MSSD).



Angat Bangsamoro: Kabataan Tungo sa Karunungan (ABK) provides financial assistance program to vulnerable students from elementary to college level. This aims to financially assist the students in their school expenses. This can be tuition fees, school supplies, school requirements, and other expenses.



Bangsamoro Sagip Kabuhayan provides capital grant worth of Php 15,000 for vulnerable family heads in Bangsamoro. This aims to help uplift Bangsamoro families by giving start-up fund to run their own livelihood/business.



Kupkup Program provides financial assistance worth of Php 5,000 to Bangsamoro Orphans. This aims to provide financial assistance for their basic needs such as grocery items, hygiene kits, and other expenses for their education.



Physical Restoration Program provides financial assistance worth of Php 20,000 for the persons with disability in the Bangsamoro. This aims to financially assist PWDs for their medication as well as adaptive equipment to make their life easier such wheelchair, standing frames, communication devices, and other devices need for disabled persons.



Solo Parent Program provides financial assistance for the vulnerable widow, separated and divorced individuals in the Bangsamoro. This aims to help solo parents through financial assistance worth of Php 5,000.

July 25, 2021| Ceremonials and Payouts for the Five Hundred Five vulnerable recipients of Transitional Development Impact Fund or TDIF took place in different Municipalities in Lanao del Sur.

Financial Assistance Received by the beneficiaries varies per category. (143) Pupils in Elementary level received Php 1,000 assistance (Angat Bangsamoro Kabataan-Elementary), (145) Students in High School Level received Php 1,500 assistance (Angat Bangsamoro Kabataan-Highschool), (101) students in College Level received Php 10,000 assistance (Angat Bangsamoro Kabataan-College), (35) Orphan beneficiaries (Kupkup Program) received Php 5,000, (73) Solo Parents received Php 5,000, (7) Bangsamoro Sagip Kabuhayan beneficiaries received Php 15,000, and (1) Person with Disability beneficiary received Php 20,000.

28 DISTRICT SUPERVISORS IN LANAO RECEIVED MULTI-PURPOSE PRINTING MACHINE AND INKS

The pandemic has affected not only the livelihood source of the people but the access to education among the learners in the Bangsamoro and nation-wide. It has changed the students' learning into online and modular type. This has caused education hard to access especially to those vulnerable ones.

Teachers are also affected by the new learning type. They encounter challenges on how will they be able to produce modules for thousands of learners.

This year, many schools have been raising their issues and concerns on the production of the modules for the learners.

Thus, the Office of Member of Parliament Atty. Maisara Cudia Dandamun-Latiph through its Transitional Development Impact Fund or TDIF funded by the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) under the leadership of Chief Minister Ahod Ebrahim took an action on the problem on the production of modules through the provision of Multi-Functional Printing Machines and Inks. Machines are purchased by the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE)

The Risograph Machine can produce up to 200,000 free prints. It can also scan maximum of 100 pages at once with high speed single-path duplex. It scans through its box, cloud and searchable PDF (OCR) and MS Office.

Siyap ko mga Mananagontaman Mageskwela in Aid of Legislation Program

Last January 2021, the Office of MP Atty. Maisara C. Dandamun Latiph launched its educational assistance program entitled “Siyap Ko Mananagontaman Mageskwela Program” for the vulnerable students from Marawi City and Lanao del Sur. The first batch of the program was implemented from January to September 2021, while the second batch was implemented from April to September 2021.

Through the signed memorandum of agreement between the office of MP Atty. Maisara C. Dandamun - Latiph and 62 student recipients, the program was conducted by giving two-thousand five hundred pesos (2,500.00) to each recipient every month in the school year 2020 to 2021. The first batch was implemented in nine (9) months with a total expense budget of 697,500. While the second batch was implemented in six (6) months with a total expense budget of 465,000. To date, the program has been allotted 1,162,500 from the office MOOE.



The program aims to provide cash assistance to the financially challenged students who are officially enrolled in senior high and college level. It is a great help for the students especially in the new normal in education. It supports their studies, like their daily meals for those in the college level staying in Marawi City, supports their purchasing needed materials for their school requirements like projects, payment for enrollment, modules and exam, internet load for online classes and other expenses in school requirements. In addition, some beneficiaries shared the cash assistance also helped their family's basic needs, they gave their extra money to their parents or guardians.

The program involves (2) discussions from the invited resource persons. The first discussion was about "Lake Lanao As Beneficial Component of the Environment" presented by Professor Hanan T. Khabab. The second discussion was about "The Current issues and concern on Forest Protection in the Province of Lanao del Sur" presented by Forester Asnawi A. Dataman, MSES, the CENRE Officer of 1st district, Lanao del Sur.

Among the Key Result Areas involve: 1. The issues, factors, and activities that are affecting adversely (negatively) affecting the health of Lake Lanao; 2. Causes the activities that negatively affect the lake, 3. Existing government actions regarding the issues on the lake, Programs focusing on protecting, preserving and conserving of Ranaw; and 4. Suggestions and recommendations.

"We, Meranaws, must be the first people to care for our natural resources. Those resources benefit us in a manner that we do not even realize. And what scares me the most is the fact that some people may forget that there are also people who will be living after them, that there are people who will either suffer or enjoy their surroundings, that there are children who may not be able to see the scenic beauty of Lake Lanao and the freshwater that flows in some areas of Lanao del Sur.", said by MP Atty. On the same side, people of the poor, homeless or financially unable to sustain their families also deserve a share of the sacrifice.", said by MP Atty. Maisara
